

HEAVY GREASE SPOTS – INTERIOR

Tools Needed

- Clean Wiping Cloth or Single-Use Towel
- Non-Abrasive Pads
- Clean Pail
- DCT Heavy Duty Degreaser Spray Bottle
- Safety Ladder / Step Ladder
- See Special Directions

Product Needed

DCT Heavy Duty Degreaser



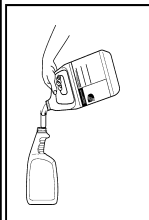
FREQUENCY OF CLEANING: *As needed.*

SPECIAL DIRECTIONS FOR THIS TASK: *If a safety ladder or step ladder is necessary for cleaning surfaces or areas associated with this procedure, please be sure to follow the safety ladder or step ladder manufacturer's safety instructions for proper and safe ladder / step ladder usage.*

If sensitivity to cleaning solutions is a concern, wear single use gloves.

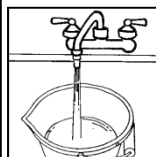
STEP 1

- Fill Heavy Duty Degreaser spray bottle with the degreaser from the gallon bottle. Attach sprayer tightly to the bottle.



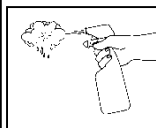
STEP 2

- Fill a clean pail with clean hot water from the faucet to the 1-gallon mark.



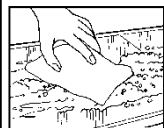
STEP 3

- Spray a small amount of degreaser onto the soiled area. For tough soils, allow degreaser to remain on soil for 3-5 minutes.



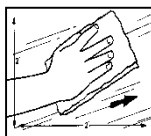
STEP 4

- Scrub surface with a clean wiping cloth, single-use towel or non-abrasive pad.



STEP 5

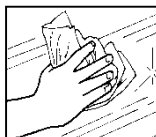
- Rinse cleaned area using a clean wiping cloth or single-use towel and the hot water in the pail.



NOTE: *Change rinse water when it becomes dirty.*

STEP 6

- Wipe area dry with a clean wiping cloth or single-use towel.



STEP 7

- If used, remove and discard single use gloves.
- Wash hands before returning to service area.
