MOP-ON RESTORER

Tools Needed

- · Wet Floor Sign
- Mop Bucket and Wringer
- · Clean, Dry Rayon Mop
- Plastic Liner

Product Needed

P&G Pro Line Spray Buff / Maintainer



FREQUENCY OF CLEANING: Bi-weekly or as needed to repair surface imperfections which cannot be repaired with daily maintenance procedures.

PREPARATION: Collect all tools, equipment and products required. Ensure all equipment is operational. Review MSDS, product labels and caution statements. Choose appropriate safety equipment.

SPECIAL DIRECTIONS FOR THIS TASK: When finished, clean and return equipment to storage closet.



STEP 1

· Remove grit and loose soil by following the Dust Mop Procedure.



STEP 2

Wet clean floor using one of the following procedures: Damp Mop Procedure. Disinfecting Damp Mop Procedure or Automatic Scrubber Floor Cleaning Procedure.



STEP 3

Put out wet floor sign in area to be serviced.

NOTE: Floors must be completely dry before performing mop-on restore.



STEP 4

- · Line mop bucket with plastic liner.
- Fill mop bucket to 3 gallon line with cold water.
- Add 1 bottle (1 gallon) spray buff / maintainer.

NOTE: Proper dilution of spray buff / maintainer is 42 ounces to 1 gallon cold water. Amount of solution should be adjusted according to size of area to be serviced.



· Submerge mop in solution.

NOTE: Always start with a clean, dry rayon mop.




 Twist lower half of mop in wringer and wring out solution.

NOTE: Top portion of mop will feed mop with right amount of Spray Buff / Maintainer for a thin, uniform coat.



STEP 7

- · Starting at farthest point from door, frame a 10 ft. by 10 ft. area with mop.
- Mop inside frame using a figure-8 motion.





working towards doorway and repeat Step 5 through Step 8.

STEP 9

• When entire area is complete, remove liner from bucket, twist, tie and discard.

STEP 10

- Product will dry to a dull haze.
- To restore gloss by Burnishing follow the Burnishing Procedure.
- To restore gloss by buffing proceed to Step 11.

STEP 11

- Mount red buffing floor pad to machine.
- Starting at farthest point from door, buff area using a left to right / right to left motion, overlapping each pass.



NOTE: Keep floor machine moving while buffing. Running machine in same spot can leave deep swirls in the finish.

NOTE: Flip or change pads as needed.
