

# WALK-IN COOLERS

## Tools Needed

- Clean Towels
- Non-Abrasive Pad
- Broom and Dustpan

## Product Needed

Spic and Span® Disinfecting All-Purpose Spray and Glass Cleaner (3-in-1)



**FREQUENCY OF CLEANING:** Weekly.

**SPECIAL DIRECTIONS FOR THIS TASK:** If sensitivity to cleaning solutions is a concern, wear disposable gloves.



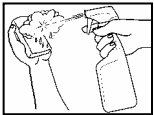
### STEP 1

- Sweep walk-in cooler before starting.
- Discard debris in trash container.



### STEP 2

- Move the food to another rack or shelf to avoid getting any cleaner on food containers.



- Spray 3-in-1 all-purpose cleaner from spray bottle onto clean towel or non-abrasive pad.
- Scrub racks until clean.

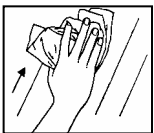


### STEP 3

- Pull storage racks away from wall to clean walls behind racks.

**CAUTION:** If racks are not on wheels, get assistance to move racks.

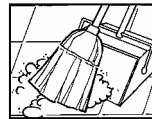
- Spray 3-in-1 all-purpose cleaner onto wall and door gaskets.
- Wipe with clean towel.



### STEP 4

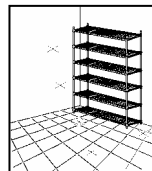
- Clean the wall surfaces by scrubbing from the bottom of the wall and moving up.
- Replace towel when it becomes dirty.

**NOTE:** Turn off fan prior to cleaning. Be sure to wipe the fan guards and light shields.



### STEP 5

- While the storage racks are pulled out from the wall after cleaning the walls, sweep the floors and discard debris.
- Clean the floors following the [Floor Cleaning Procedure](#).



### STEP 6

- Push the storage racks back against the wall.
- Clean the center of the floor using the [Floor Cleaning Procedure](#).
- Air-dry surfaces.



### STEP 7

- If used, remove and discard disposable gloves.
- Wash hands before returning to service area.
