# Floors - Damp Mop

#### **Products Needed**



Spic and Span® Floor and Multi-Surface Cleaner

#### **Tools Needed**

- Broom and Dust Pan
- Mop
- Mop Bucket
- Wet Floor Sign

#### **Frequency**

Daily

### **Special Directions**

Change out the floor cleaning solution when it becomes dirty and after every use.

## Damp Mop



Sweep floor.



Mop a 10 foot by 10 foot area using a figure–8 motion and turning over mop at least twice.



Move to the next 10 foot by 10 foot area and repeat Steps 5 to 7 until this task is finished.

Place the mop head

in the solution and

move up and down

until the mop is

soaking wet.

**Hardened Soil Removal** 



Damp mop the area to remove the loosened soil and cleaner residues using Steps 5 to 7 in the Damp Mop section of this procedure.



Put out the wet floor sign.



Fill mop bucket 4 gallons of water. Push the hand pump of <u>Spic and Span Floor Multi Surface Cleaner</u> into the mop bucket. Pump (2) full strokes, or 1/2 oz of product for every 1 gallon of water used.



Wet the hardened floor soil deposit and allow to soak 5 minutes.



Place mop head in solution and move mop up and down until the mop is soaking wet.



Twirl mop head to open skirt to exposes the interior scouring pad and then drop the mop.



Place the mop head in the mop wringer and wring out as much solution as possible.



Scrub the area with the interior scouring pad to loosen the soil.
