

CCT 210 OPL Replace Empty Product Container

Tools Needed

- Bucket Wrench [Sized for 5 gallon or 15 gallon]
- Gloves, Disposable
- Goggles, Safety

Frequency

Special Directions

Disposable gloves and safety goggles must be worn when handling concentrated chemicals.

NOTE: This phone fix closely matches a generic OPL wall chart usually hung in the laundry area called "To Replace an Empty Container" 0360-0014

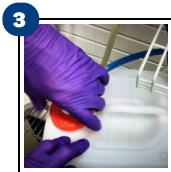
The procedure steps are the same for a 5 gallon or 15 gallon product container



1 Put on gloves and goggles.



2 Visually check the remaining level of the product.



3 **REMOVE** cap from empty container.



4 **LOCATE** the bucket wrench stored above the pump stand or hanging near it.

NOTE: Some locations may have lost the bucket wrench. A hardware store hand tool like a Channellock wrench can be used if the bucket wrench is missing.

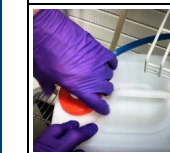
The 15 gallon containers have a different style bucket wrench than the 5 gallon containers. Currently, there are two different style 15 gallon bucket wrenches in the system.



5 **REPLACE** with a new full container. Use the bucket wrench to **REMOVE** the white shipping cap.



6 **TWIST ON** the mating cap. Visually **INSPECT** for improper seating. **PUSH DOWN** on the cap while turning until you can hand tighten it while properly seating the mating cap.



7 Place white shipping cap on empty container before disposal.
